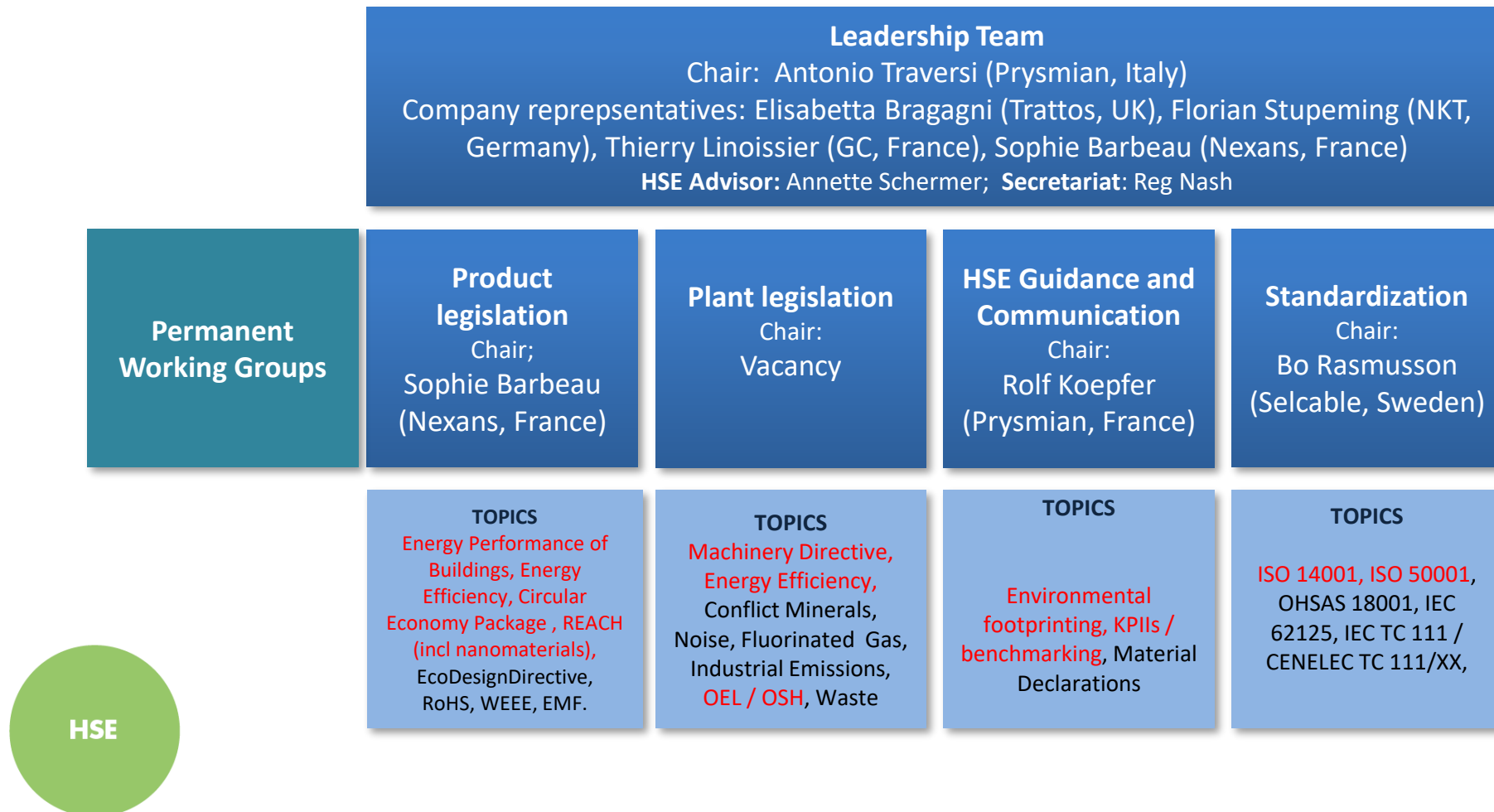

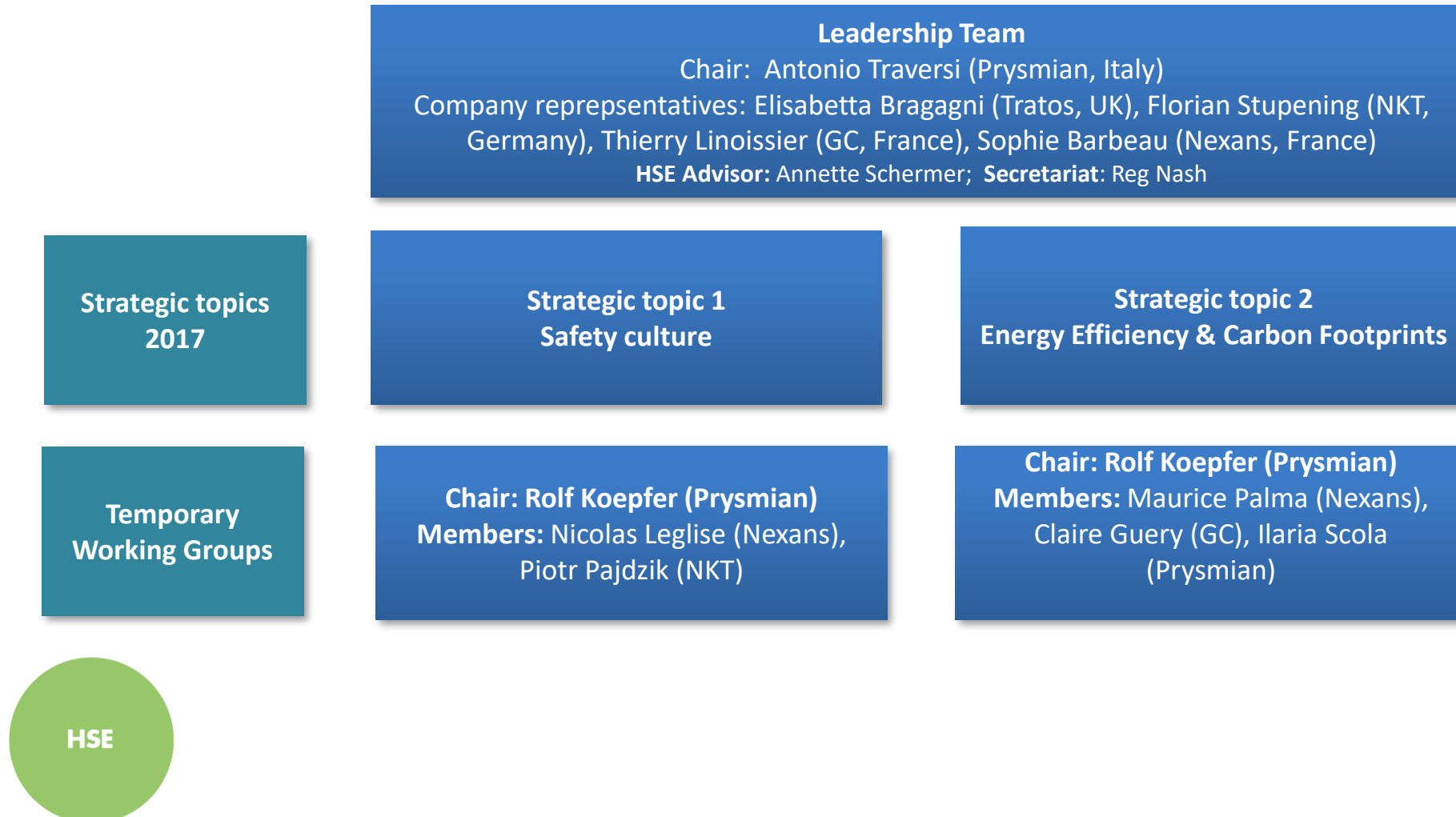

HSE Team – 2016 / 2017 Achievements (1)

Highlights

- Widening of scope to strategic business issues: safety culture and carbon emissions (energy efficiency and footprint)
 - Benchmarking performance on Strategic issues in progress
 - Sharing best practices workshops planned
- Revised organizational structure
 - Additional resources for strategic issues
 - Liaison with Working Group Materials strengthened
 - Increased attention to Management of Substance and Material evaluation
 - Environmental standards now include in HSE scope to ensure alignment with Europacable technical Committees
- DG Environment: Successful management of Regulatory Decisions
 - Extensive lobbying and input on ADCA - Decision on regulating ADCA postponed
 - Management of proposals on Phthalates
 - Cables excluded from ECO Design Directive – Energy and Data

HSE Team – 2016 / 2017 Achievements (2)

Highlights

- C** Ongoing monitoring of regulations and standards (products / plant)
 - C** ADCA - RMOA report completed
 - Basic RMOA for potentially regulated substances
 - C** Overview of relevant environmental standards now in place
 - C** Upcoming substance issues relevant to cable (related) production
 - High priority: **orange lead** and **lead monoxide** recommended for authorization - Significant issue for Europacable members
 - High priority: **NMP** - Managed by winding wire group
 - **UV stabilisers** in public consultation for next recommendation for authorization.
 - Revision of WEEE and Recycling of products

HSE Team – 2017 / 2018 Additional actions

2017 / 2018 Focus

- Increased focus on legislation having material impact on Europacable members
- Increased liaison with EU departments for HSE matters
- Increased liaison with Orgalime and provision of Comments on Consultation process
- Ongoing assessment of Environmental Standards
- Provision of HSE Guidance to Europacable members
- Increased use of National Association influence on National Environmental Committees
- Review of resource planning (including review of EU Grants /subsidies) and future experience requirements to be undertaken
- Development of HSE Newsletter
- Revision of Europacable Material Declaration document
