 - C Overview of relevant environmental standards now in place
 - C Upcoming substance issues relevant to cable (related) production
 - High priority: orange lead and lead monoxide recommended for authorization - Significant issue for Europacable members
 - High priority: **NMP** Managed by winding wire group
 - **UV stabilisers** in public consultation for next recommendation for authorization.
 - Revision of WEEE and Recycling of products
